Dear BBHHS Marching Bees Band Family:

My name is Rory Gallagher and I am a Junior in the percussion section of the Brecksville Broadview Heights High School Marching Bees, as well as an 8 year member of The Boy Scouts of America ("BSA"). As some of you may know, Eagle Scout is the highest rank in the BSA and in order to achieve that rank a candidate must complete a project that benefits an organization. Since the Marching Band has done so much for me, I decided to try and give back to this wonderful organization.

Project Goal/Description

The project I have in mind is to build new cabinets for the storage of percussion equipment. I intend to build seven cabinets and place them in the main band room. This will free up a huge amount of room in the Instrument locker room to help expedite the process of getting the band ready for a game, practice, class, etc. To do this, I need to purchase a large amount of wood to construct the cabinets as well as paint, screws, nails, and other building materials.

Funding Needed

As you may guess, wood is not very cheap and the expected cost of the wood is the main reason I need to raise as much money as I do. How much you ask? Well, I need to raise approximately \$3,000.00 for the majority of the project, which will pay for all necessary materials. Along with asking for donations of all sizes from the band family, Mr. Wyse had the idea to allow for the purchase of plaques that can be dedicated in honor of someone and placed on the cabinets. For example, I intend to purchase a plaque in honor of my Grandparents. Obviously, there will be a limited amount of plaques available for purchase. For each donation of at least \$25.00, a small plaque with the name of the person or persons to be honored will be placed on the cabinets.
