All student leaders, appointed and elected, agree to adhere to the following to support the BBHHS Band motto: *“Look Good. Sound Good. Be A Class Act.”*

LOOK GOOD

- Uphold all rehearsal expectations.
- Demonstrate proper marching visuals at all times.
- Uphold all uniform expectations.
- Demonstrate proper instrument/equipment care at all times.
- Lead other students in upholding all rehearsal expectations, proper marching visuals, uniform expectations, and instrument/equipment care.

SOUND GOOD

- Demonstrate proper musicality and tone quality in rehearsal, performance, and in band stands.
- Complete music memorization check-offs by the predetermined deadlines.
 - Section Leaders/Officers - TWO WEEKS before a performance.
 - Squad Leaders/Librarians/Equipment Managers - ONE WEEK before a performance.
 - All other band members - 24 hours before a performance.
- Demonstrate proper execution of all vocal responses to marching commands.
- Submit all Chair Placements/Band Auditions by predetermined deadlines.
- Lead other students in upholding all musical standards, completion of music check-offs and auditions by deadlines, and execution of vocal responses to marching commands.

BE A CLASS ACT

- Follow all rules, guidelines, and procedures in the Band Handbook.
- Demonstrate proper use of social media as defined in Band Handbook.
- Refrain from using foul language at band events and whenever in uniform.
- Demonstrate selfless service leadership by doing the thankless duties (cleaning up band/music area after band events, racking chairs/stands, being first ones to arrive/last to leave, etc.)
- Demonstrate proper self-care and responsibility before and during rehearsals/performances.
- Maintain a positive attitude at all times.
- Support the directors, leaders, and chaperones at all times and address any concerns in private.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship at athletic events.
- Create a respectful, fun, and nurturing family culture within the band.
- Lead all students to being a class act by fulfilling all the aforementioned expectations.
