Senior Night Information

We are looking forward to **recognizing the Senior Class of 2021 at our first HOME Football Game vs. Hudson this Friday, September 4th!** This document is to outline some important information and logistics for the evening.

PREGAME Recognition

- All Senior student participants (band/cheer/football) will be recognized and walk across the track prior to the Marching Bees Pregame performance.
- Senior students are allowed two(2) family members to escort them as they walk across the track.
*Due to COVID spectator restrictions, **there can be no more than two (2) family escorts***

Tickets for Senior Families (Stadium / Lawn)

- In addition to the two (2) stadium tickets that may be purchased by families to spectate their student participant(s), senior families also have the option to purchase two (2) "lawn" tickets for this game. This "lawn" ticket option is for senior students/families **only**.
- Stadium Tickets (FREE FOR SENIOR FAMILIES)
 - ARE FREE FOR SENIOR FAMILIES
 - Presale forms need to be submitted at tonight's rehearsal (Mon 8/31)
 - This ticket allows you into the stadium.
- Lawn Tickets (SENIOR FAMILIES ONLY - MUST BE PAID)
 - Are \$3 each. Presale forms will be passed out at tonight's rehearsal and must be returned by Wed 9/2 evening rehearsal.
 - This will be a wristband. This allows you to sit on the elevated portion of the HS parking lot to watch the game/performance.
 - **The wristband does not allow you into the stadium.**
 - Restrooms facilities will be provided outside the stadium.

Schedule & Itinerary

- A full itinerary for this evening will be communicated soon.
- Senior students and the two family members that will be escorting them during Pregame, will need to arrive at 5:30pm.
- This allows enough time to get into appropriate alphabetical order and put on mums/flowers.
- We plan to begin reading the band seniors names at 6:00pm.

There are many people working hard to make this evening happen. We are looking forward to devoting a time of recognition to our deserving senior class of 2021. All students have been through a great deal in recent months and our seniors are more than deserving for this opportunity to celebrate their efforts and dedication to the band program.
