

***BBHHS Marching Bees  
Trunk or Treat Directions***

**Parking Instructions:**

Location - Please proceed to the **Senior Lot** at the High School. This is the lot directly in front of the auditorium. Look for volunteers parking cars on the side opposite the football field, near the trees. We will be parking in every other spot to provide social distancing at this event.

Timing - **Please arrive about one hour before the event time** to get parked in the designated portion of the Senior lot, and do a preliminary set up of your trunk decorations. If we have a tailgate performance, this would be between 5-5:30 (start at 6 pm); if we have a football game, this would be 5:30-6 pm (pregame starts at 6:30). This gives our parent “treaters” and volunteers time to make their way to the stadium and get their seats before our Marching Bees begin.

**At the end of the event** (tailgate or game), please proceed back to your car to prepare your final set up for the kids. We are going to delay the kids for about 10-15 minutes, after the performance or game is over to give you time to prepare!

**Treat Instructions:**

Please bring **300 pieces** of candy to ensure that we have enough for all of our Marching Bees!

Treats may be passed out in one of three ways:

1. Gloves: Parent may put treats into the kids bags using a gloved hand. Students may NOT reach into a community bowl for treats.
2. Grab and Go: Parents may individually bag treats and set them in the trunk or on a table, for a grab and go approach. Please encourage students to only touch the bag they are taking with them.
3. Novel delivery: Parents may provide for a novel delivery method. Examples: PVC chute, where students can hold their bag up to the end, and the parent can slide the treat down to them. Clothesline type approach, where treats are pinned individually to a string, tied between the car and a stepstool/ladder. You can be creative, but the goal is to put distance between the treaters and the Marching Bees, if possible.

**General Instructions:**

- COVID masks are mandatory. Masks must be worn appropriately at all times by both students and parents for the protection of all!
- Costumes for both parents and students are encouraged but not required! Costume choices should be within the school’s code of conduct.
- Trunk decorations are encouraged, but not required. Remember, it will be dark or nearly dark when the treating happens, so please consider lights or glow in the dark decorations!
